Multipurpose Senior Services Program (MSSP)	This waiver provides Home and Community-Based Services to Medi-Cal eligible individuals who are 65 years or older and disabled as an alternative to nursing facility placement, allowing individuals to remain safely in their homes. To receive services, an individual must meel all of the following criteria: must be a Medi-Cal individual who, but for the provision of such services would require SNF level of care, aged 65 or older,	Multipurpose Senior Services Program (MSSP) (ca.gov)
	can only be enrolled in 1 HCBS waiver at any time, must reside in a county with an MSSP site.	
Home and Community Based Waiver (HCBA)	This waiver provides long-term support for persons at risk for nursing home or institutional placement, as long as member, remains eligible, and services are determined appropriate. There is a potential for RN and/or LVN care. To receive services as an HCBA participant, an individual must meet all of the following criteria: meet criteria for hospital length of care, for 90 consecutive days or greater, and required medical criteria, able to safely and sustainably receive their required care in their homes, have full-scope Medi-Cal with zero share of cost, and meet the program's current income limits. Community Based Adult Services (CBAS)	CBAS offers services to eligible older adults and/or adults with disabilities to restore or maintain their optimal capacity for self-care and delay or prevent inappropriate or personally undesirable institutionalization. Services include; individual assessment, nursing services, therapies (PT/OT/ST), MH services, therapeutic activities, social services, personal care, a meal, nutritional counseling, transportation to/from home and center. Eligibility to participate in CBAS is determined by the beneficiary's MediCal Managed Care Plan.	Community Based Adult Services (CBAS)/Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) Transition
In Home Supportive Services (IHSS)	The IHSS Public Authority is to improve the quality of life for IHSS recipients in order to live safely in their own homes w/ independence and dignity. IHSS supports seniors and persons with disabilities by providing access to pre-screened care providers who can deliver compassionate and timely care. The types of services which can be authorized through IHSS are housecleaning, meal preparation, laundry, grocery shopping, personal care services (such as bowel and bladder care, bathing, grooming and paramedical services), accompaniment to medical appointments, and protective supervision for the mentally impaired. Individuals may be eligible if; 65 years of age or older, disabled or blind, SSI/SSP or MediCal eligible, are living in a home/apt/abode of their choosing (does not include hospital, nursing home, assisted living, or licensed facility), present functional impairment and are at risk for out of home care placement.
