
Protect yourself from breast cancer by getting a mammogram!

Mammograms (breast X-rays) are used to screen for breast cancer.

Regular breast cancer screening with mammograms can help find breast cancer early, when it might be easier to treat.

A mammogram is a low-dose X-ray of the breast that's used to look for breast changes.

Mammograms can find tumors that are too small for you or your doctor to feel. X-ray pictures of each breast are taken, usually from two different angles.

A mammogram can be uncomfortable but is not usually painful.
It usually takes just five minutes total.



Ready for your screening? Here are the steps to take:



Call your Primary Care Provider (PCP) today to ask for a mammogram referral.



Schedule your appointment at your preferred lab. Please see list.



Show up 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment time.



Be proud of yourself! Getting screened is important for your health, and you did it!



Are you worried about being exposed to radiation during a mammogram?

The machine takes X-rays at lower doses of radiation than the X-rays done to look at other parts of the body. Your doctor is available to discuss any questions or concerns.
